A flu vaccine is required of students if one of the two following situations pertains to them:

- The student will be in Chile during **Chile's flu season** – in this case, the student will need to receive their flu shot when they arrive to Santiago. Flu shots are available at UC clinics and hospitals. Chile's flu risk exists from May through September. Students immunized with the current formulation > 6 months earlier should consider revaccination because immunity may have declined.
- The **student is coming from a Northern Hemisphere country** currently **experiencing their flu season**. For example, students from the US would need to show proof of receiving the flu vaccine if traveling to Chile during the flu season of the US (November – April).

If the rotations dates do not apply to any of the above scenarios, a flu vaccine is not required.
